The annual CAMPP Executive Meeting took place in Kansas City on October 1st and 2nd, 2010. Among the topics covered were the scheduling of the 2011 CAMPP Conference in October, the state of CAMPP membership and financial stability, accreditation updates, relationships with the APA, and upcoming regulatory decisions regarding Master's level programs.

The 2011 CAMPP Conference will be held in November in San Diego, California. A call for papers and posters is forthcoming.

Membership continues to be a focus of the Executive Committee, and the Commission currently maintains a membership of 41 Master's granting institutions. CAMPP has worked closely with the APA and COGDOP for recognition of Master's programs in psychology, and

both organizations have been supportive in granting CAMPP members the opportunity to participate in ongoing education and accreditation meetings. Among the key legislative decisions being followed by CAMPP are the use of Master's level practitioners under the new health care legislation and individual state programs utilizing Master's level practitioners.
